

Application to the Boulder Seminar

We are pleased that you're interested in joining the Boulder Jung Seminar, which is part of the Boulder Association of Jungian Analysts (BAJA). Below are the admission requirements and some questions that will help us get to know you. The seminar requires regular attendance and a commitment to psyche.

To apply for admission:

- A. Please email or contact Boulder Seminar Coordinator, Nora Swan-Foster 303-440-4000 or nora@swanfoster.com.
- B. Required:
 1. A completed **Boulder Seminar Application Form** (follows below).
 2. A two page **Autobiography** of your personal and psychological development along with why you are interested in joining the Jung Seminar, your knowledge of Jungian theory and how it has informed and given meaning to your daily life. If you are reapplying to the seminar, discuss the process of departure and reasons for reapplication showing psychological curiosity, depth and connection to the unconscious.

*If you were once a member of the seminar and now wish to rejoin, you need to go through a reapplication process. There is no guarantee that you will be admitted as there are several factors that the committee considers in the admissions process. Applications are considered in the order in which they are received.
- B. Please send by regular mail the following items to Nora Swan-Foster, 1137 Pearl Street, Suite 205, Boulder, CO, 80302. After a brief conversation, these materials will be forwarded to the Membership Coordinator, Elizabeth Retivov, who will complete the admissions process.
 1. **Boulder Seminar Agreement**, printed out, dated and signed (follows on page 3).
 2. A **non-refundable \$100 application fee**. Please make your check payable to BAJA. If the seminar is of interest, an interview will be scheduled. If you are accepted, we ask for a \$200 deposit to secure your registration. There is no refund given for your deposit after July 1st should you decide to withdraw from the seminar once you're accepted and paid a deposit.

Please send your application as soon as it is complete. **Deadline for submission of application material for enrollment is May 15th for admission at the start of the seminar year in September.** Should the seminar be full, your application will be placed on a wait-list. Applicants are reviewed and interviewed in the order that they are received. There is no admission to the seminar mid-year and reapplications for the seminar are not guaranteed a slot and are required to have an interview process.

Boulder Jung Seminar Agreement

This on-going seminar offers education in Jungian thought and provides an opportunity to integrate these concepts into practice as well as participate in a community that values Analytical psychology. The seminar is also a forum to become aware of your own psychological dynamics and understand how they interact with those of your patients as well as people in your life. A certificate of attendance will be provided for all seminar participants.

- I understand that the seminar faculty **strongly** recommends that I have on-going regular Jungian analysis with a certified Jungian analyst, particularly if you have an interest in applying to Jungian training in the future. Regular Jungian psychotherapy is acceptable. _____
- I recognize that **registration is for the full year**—two semesters—and by signing below I do understand this as a full year commitment as the seminar does not accept applicants part way through the year. _____
- I understand tuition for the first semester (\$700) is due on August 1st, with the second semester tuition (\$700) due by December 1st. I understand that there is a tuition discount of \$100 for those paying for the full year (\$1300) by July 1st. A payment plan may be considered under very special circumstances and require agreement from the BAJA treasurer. _____
- I understand that participation in this seminar will not provide me with a degree, a license to practice psychotherapy, or certificate or diploma in analytical psychology. Attendance in the seminar does not automatically give the legal right to practice analysis or psychotherapy. Acquiring legal status to practice as a psychotherapist remains the personal and ethical responsibility of the individual. The laws governing professional certification vary in different states, and it is my responsibility to meet the legal requirements of the state in which I intend to practice psychotherapy. I also agree not to designate myself as a Jungian analyst, without having been conferred the degree of Jungian Analyst by an appropriate organization, and having satisfied the legal requirements of the state in which I intend to practice. _____
- I understand that should I wish to apply for training with the IRSJA, this institution will have specific requirements regarding supervision hours and licensure. _____
- I understand that acceptance and participation in the seminar does not automatically guarantee me a slot in the seminar in future years. I understand if I withdraw from the seminar, I will need to reapply. _____
- I also understand that decisions by the Admissions Committee regarding admissions may not be appealed. _____
- I am aware that clinical material may be discussed in seminar and that such material is considered **confidential** and should remain within the container of the seminar. _____
- I realize that special circumstances require changes in the syllabus. The seminar coordinator will do everything possible to make the adjustment as smooth as possible. _____
- I am aware that participation in the Friday social gathering prior to the first seminar date is required. _____
